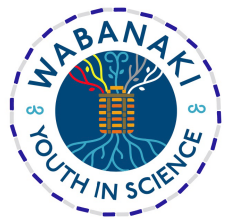

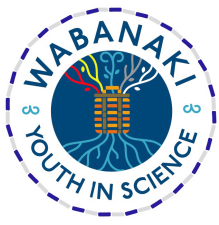

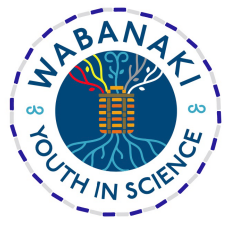
General job responsibilities:
